### Adhesives

- New, sealed, & not expired



### Appliances

- 10 years old or newer
- Clean & fully functional
- Dishwasher - 5 years or newer
- Washers & electric dryers, refrigerators, stoves & ovens, range hoods / tops, microwaves



### Architectural Items

- Structurally sound
- Columns, mantels, porch posts, banisters, railings



### Bath

- Provide all parts, accessories, brackets, & hardware
- Towel bars, soap dishes, TP & toothbrush holders, handicap grab bars & support items



### Cabinets

- Individual pieces
- Full sets



### Caulk

- New, sealed, & not expired



### Ceiling Tile & Grid

- Ceiling Tile - **new only**, manufactured after 1980
- Original packaging marked with manufactured date or clearly labeled "no asbestos"
- Grid Pieces - Full lengths



### Counter Tops

- All material types
- At least 4 feet long, unless accompanying matching cabinet
- No chips, cracks, or damage
- Formica, granite, marble, Corian, etc.



### Doors

- Interior & exterior
- All panes must be intact
- Sliding glass - thermal only with no fogging and all track / glass intact
- Pre-hung doors, door slabs, bi-fold



### Electrical

- Residential Items Only
- No large donations of miscellaneous stock
- No painted outlet covers



### Fans

- Ceiling fans - leave ceiling fans fully assembled, all pieces required
- Box fans



### Fencing

- No rust, major tears, or other structural failure
- Chain link - fabric, gates, & top rail
- Wooden - in panels, any height
- Vinyl - full pieces or panels
- All posts - straight & clean with no concrete attached
- All other fencing materials (chicken wire, snow fence, etc.) are acceptable



### Fire Places & Gas Logs

- Provide all parts, accessories, & related hardware
- Fireplace inserts, stand-alone fire places, fronts & doors, gas logs



### Flooring

- All sheet goods to be measured, marked, & tied
- Other flooring in usable quantities, i.e. one case min.
- Carpet & padding (**new only**), vinyl tile, sheet vinyl, linoleum, hardwood, parquet, ceramic or porcelain tile



### Furniture

- No upholstered furniture
- Most wood furniture accepted
- Wood chairs, tables, dressers, outdoor furniture, etc.



### Hardware

- Complete sets of door hinges, cabinet hardware, etc.
- Nails, screws, hangers, etc. in any quantity
- Lock sets, keys included



### HVAC

- All HVAC items must be fully functional & need no repairs
- Furnaces - gas or electric, 80% or above efficiency
- Air conditioners (central outdoor unit) - 3 years old or newer, with matching evaporator if separate unit
- Air conditioners (window) - 5 years old or newer

## Insulation

- Fiber glass batts - rolled, bound, & marked with thickness & length
- Blown insulation - new bags only
- Sheet - rigid foam, half sheet minimum



## Lighting

- Light fixtures & light bulbs
- No fluorescent lights



## Lumber

- Plywood - full, half, & quarter sheets
- Milled lumber - 4 foot lengths or greater
- Trim/molding - 4 foot lengths or greater



## Masonry

- Whole units only, no cut units
- *Bricks, cinder blocks*



## Plumbing

- Neutral colors only
- Toilets - 1.6 gallon flush
- Water heaters - 3 years old or newer
- *Kitchen sinks, bathroom sink bowl, pedestal sinks, vanity tops & vanities, bathtubs, shower enclosures, plumbing hardware, pipe*



## Roofing Materials & Gutters

- New shingles - full bundles
- Rolls of roofing material - half roll minimum
- New roofing and gutter materials - full pieces



## Sheet Rock

- 2'x4' sheets or greater



## Tools

- Hand or power tools in any working condition, will sell "as-is"



## Vents

- Flooring, ceiling, & return



## Windows

- Complete units only
- Dual pane only
- All glass intact



## Miscellaneous

- Duct - all types, 2 foot sections & longer
- Thermostats - digital only
- New vinyl siding
- Stone & rock - wall, veneer, & landscape stone, must be relatively clean with little debris or mortar.
- New blinds



## Items we cannot accept:

- Aluminum or single-pane windows
- Any large stock of misc. electrical or plumbing parts
- Appliances not in working order
- Baby cribs, strollers, high chairs, playpens
- Broken glass or mirrors
- Children's beds
- Clothing
- Corded window blinds
- Drapes
- Fluorescent lights & bulbs
- Garage Doors
- Gas Dryers
- Household goods
- Ladders
- Mattresses
- Most electronic equipment
- Paint
- Paint thinner or other hazardous chemicals or materials
- Pesticides of any kind
- Screens without windows
- Smoke / Carbon Monoxide detectors
- Unframed glass or mirrors
- Upholstered furniture
- Used blinds
- Used carpet or padding
- Used siding
